Through the ages light has been the symbol of progress and truth. The Feast of Lights, depicting the spread of the Christian gospel, had its origin in the Eastern Church very early, much earlier than the observance of Christmas by the Western Church. This service inaugurates the great missionary season of the Church and proclaims Jesus as the Messiah, the Savior, the Son of God, and the true light of the world.

I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

The Lord be with you. **And with thy Spirit.** Let us pray.

Presider and People:

Almighty God, we give you thanks for surrounding us, with the brightness of your holy light; and we implore you of your great mercy that, as you enfold us with the radiance of this light, so you would shine into our hearts the brightness of your Holy Spirit; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O God, by the leading of a star you manifested your only Son to the peoples of the earth: Lead us, who know you now by faith, to your presence, where we may see your glory face to face; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. **Amen.**

AT THIS TIME THE OFFICIANT, THE WARDENS AND MEMBERS OF THE VESTRY COME FORWARD WITH THEIR CANDLES TO RECEIVE THE LIGHT FROM THE CHRIST CANDLE


